Title:	Domestic Hot Water and Heating System Shut Down
Location:	Business and Economics David Strong Buildings
Description	Be advised that Facilities Management Mechanical Shop needs to replace a faulty heat exchanger in the Business and Economics Building. In order to safely complete this work it will require shutting off the heat affecting the domestic hot water and building heating for up to eight hours. We apologize for any inconvenience this may cause.
	The building will be warm before the work begins so it is anticipated that occupants will not notice any cooling in the building. However, it is advised that occupants bring along an extra sweater in case of cooler than normal temperatures in the early afternoon.
	Additional note to all staff and students : Use of the handicapped accessible doors result in significant heat loss from the building. Given this, particularly during the shut-down, people are asked to use the handicapped accessible doors only if necessary in order to limit the heat loss. This will go a long way to helping the occupants stay warm throughout the shutdown, and at all times when the weather is cold.
