

**Bequest:** A gift to the university in your Will.

## Overview:

A bequest to the University of Victoria is a gift we receive through a special clause in your Will. Gifts can be an absolute dollar amount, a specific asset or a percentage or residue of your estate.

The clause may specify whether your gift:

- will provide immediate funding through an <u>expendable fund</u>, or be held permanently in an <u>endowment</u>. The funds in the endowment are invested and a portion of the interest income is used each year. The minimum amount suggested for establishing an endowed fund is \$25,000.
- will be <u>unrestricted</u> (used by UVic for its greatest need), or <u>restricted</u> (used for a specific purpose, e.g. a student award such as a scholarship or bursary or the funding of a special project).

## Benefits to You:

- You can provide financial support to the university that you may not have been able to provide during your lifetime.
- Support future generations of UVic students and faculty through your legacy.
- Your estate is entitled to a donation receipt for the full value of the bequest that will reduce, or even eliminate, income taxes payable by your estate.

## **Essential Information:**

- The process of leaving a gift in your Will is straightforward. With the help of your professional advisor you can add a bequest to UVic in a new Will. If you have already prepared your Will, you can update it by simply adding a codicil: a supplementary paragraph that includes your bequest.
- Each bequest is unique and, therefore, no single clause will meet everyone's needs. Once you
  have decided what you would like your gift to do, the UVic Planned Giving staff can create specific
  Will wording that you can then take to your lawyer or notary. On the second page, we have
  provided some general Will clauses as samples for your review.
