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Introduction to French for students with no previous knowledge of the language. The course focuses on the 4 aspects of language learning: oral comprehension, oral expression, written comprehension, and written expression. By the end of this intensive course, students will reach the A1 level of the European Common Framework for Languages and will have gained important intercultural competencies. Please note that this intensive course is worth 3 units and that there are 6 mandatory hours per week of scheduled classroom and lab activities.

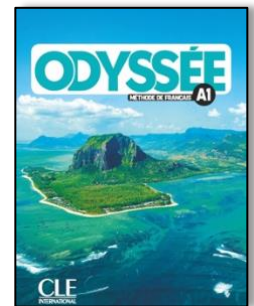
