

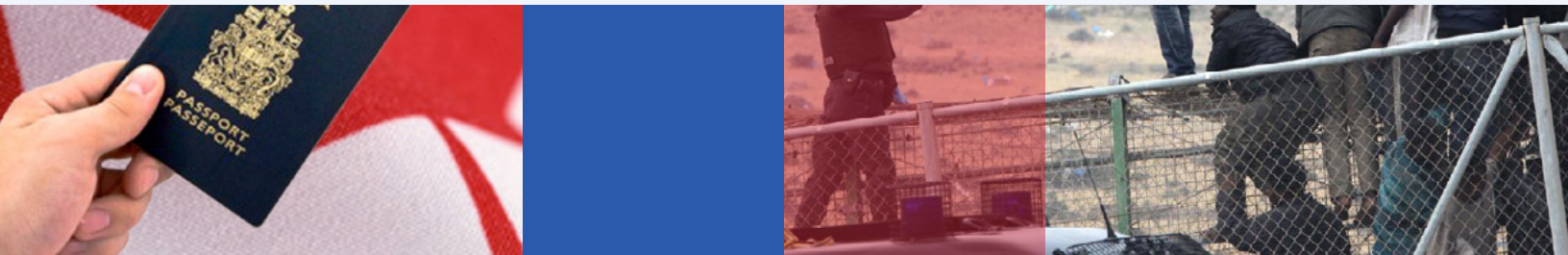

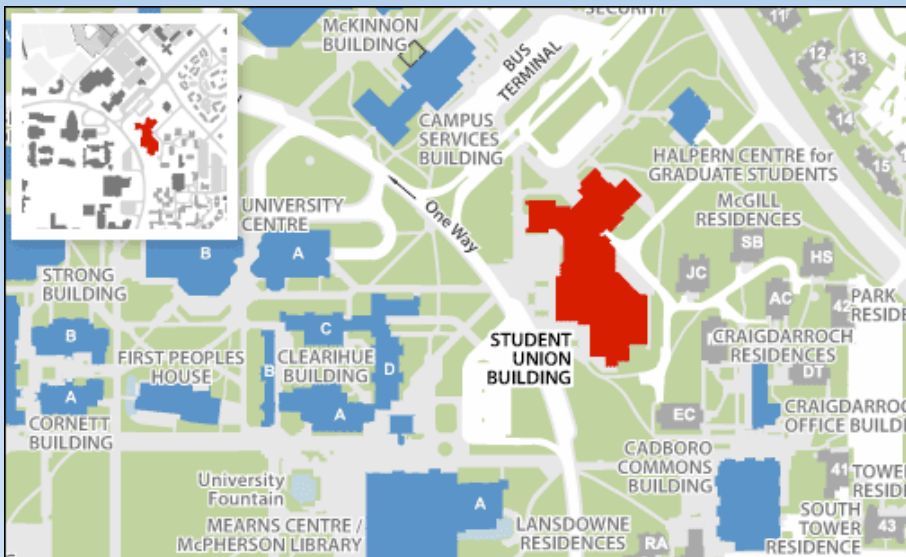




## Important Info
