

Introduction to Korean II



This introduction to basic spoken and written Korean teaches students with no prior knowledge of Korean essential words and phrases to develop their conversation skill. The instructor helps students pronounce Korean correctly and the designated textbook helps them develop listening/reading comprehension and master grammar rules. Students develop their conversational skill through suggested assignments and direct interaction with the instructor and classmates.

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Proposed Assignments:

- Quizzes: vocabulary & grammar (25 %)
- In-class Tests: comprehension and composition (20%)



- Listening test (5%)
- Individual video Project: Introducing yourself, your friend, and your and your friend's possession (5%)
- Pair Project (2 people): present a skit with your partner related to topics covered in the textbook (10%)
- Final project (25%)
