



Nomination Form for Thesis LLM External Examiners

No later than four weeks prior to submission of the thesis for examination, all LLM candidates must discuss possible thesis examiners with their two supervisors and agree with their supervisors on a list of three nominees, submitting the potential examiners' names and contact details below.

Students and supervisors must not approach any of the nominees directly about the thesis or the student's program until after the examination process is complete and the thesis returned.

The proposed examiners must:

- a. hold a graduate degree in law or in a related discipline;
- b. be from outside of the University of Victoria Law Faculty;
- c. have expertise in a field to which the thesis relates; and
- d. not be in conflict of interest with the student and in particular must not be a former teacher or referee of the student.
