JOB DESCRIPTION:

The assistant will work with a Senior Lab Instructor and Scientific Technician to help prepare the material needed for the Developmental Biology course (Biology 309). Duties will involve preparing chemicals, setting up equipment, cleaning glassware, preparing slides, testing lab experiments, cultivating chick embryos, collecting and fertilizing sea urchin eggs, mating frogs, etc. The technician will also help set up, maintain and clean the Biology 309 laboratory.

Applicants need to be available to start early January, 2025.

Successful applicants need to be available to work ~5-10 hours biweekly in the spring term, with an emphasis on being available to work 2-3 hours on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday mornings, depending on the lab teaching schedule. Shifts can be split around class schedules.

QUALIFICATIONS:

Successful completion of Biology 230, or other equivalent second year Biology course. Consideration will be made for students currently registered in Biology 230.

An upper level student in Biology with demonstrated experience in molecular biology would be an asset. Students who have previously completed or who are currently registered in Biology 309 will be preferred.
