#### JOB DESCRIPTION:

The work study student will be a key Visitor Engagement team member and will be trained by our Visitor Engagement staff specialist. In this role, the student will welcome visitors, orient them to the gallery and exhibition(s), and meaningfully engage visitors in the exhibition content as well as record attendance stats and conversation highlights.

Additional duties include gallery opening and closing procedures, assisting with set up and take down for events, assisting with the delivery of online or in person public programs and assisting with distribution of publicity material. Other learning opportunities may include assisting with exhibition preparation and take down, cataloguing art and artifacts, and data entry as time permits. Visitor Engagement Assistants should expect to work a minimum of 4 hours per week to accommodate opening hours 10 am to 4 pm Wed to Sat.
