JOB DESCRIPTION:

This project is being led by CIFAL Victoria, a joint initiative of the United Nations Institute for Training and Research (UNITAR) and the University of Victoria since 2022. <u>CIFAL Victoria</u> provides UN accredited training and research to advance the implementation of the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), especially those pertaining to global health and wellbeing; decolonization and Indigenous Knowledges; innovation and entrepreneurship; and oceans, climate and sustainability.

The successful candidate would be responsible for supporting a campus-wide asset mapping initiative of academic courses, initiatives, and activities with content addressing the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). In order to support this work, CIFAL Victoria is updating <u>its original SDG dashboard</u> (originally created in 2022) and data management around the SDG activities more broadly. The goal is to work collaboratively with faculty, staff, and units across campus to better identify and promote learning opportunities for prospective and current students.

Typical duties and responsibilities:

- Refine methodology/criteria for SDG keywords at UVic
- Data collection, validation and continue building the dashboard
- Use Power BI dashboard to present SDG courses, initiatives, activities no campus
- Support data visualization
- Support promotion and communications of SDG related courses at UVic
- Assist in other duties related to identifying and tracking SDG activities around campus
