Animal Care Services: Training Cancellation, No-Show & Late Arrival Policy

Animal Care Services Training sessions for <u>Facility Orientations</u> and <u>Hands-on Training sessions</u> are free-of-charge; however, starting September 1 2023, a department FAST account is needed for registration. A cancellation or no-show <u>fee</u> will apply to cover costs of time and supplies. Fees are detailed below, based on typical course duration.

To avoid a no-show or cancellation <u>fee</u>, trainees must provide a minimum of 24 hours' notice for both **Facility Orientations** and **Hands-on Training** sessions via email at animaltraining@uvic.ca. If the cancellation notice is not received on time, the FAST account will be charged based on the course fees below. If a trainee from a Principal Investigator's (PI's) lab cancels without appropriate notice, or does not attend a training session, the fee will be waived **only once** for that PI as a courtesy. Subsequent cancellations without notice/non-attendance from that PI's lab will be charged the full fee.

If an orientation or hands-on training session has been booked within 24 hours of the scheduled session, the late cancellation policy will already be in effect.

Late Arrivals: Trainees are allowed a 10-minute grace period for late arrival only once. Those arriving to the training room more than 10 minutes after the scheduled start time must reschedule, and a no-show fee will apply.

If ACS training staff can fill your appointment time with another trainee, all or a portion of the charge may be waived.

If a trainee cannot attend the session due to illness, they need to promptly notify the ACS Training team via email at animaltraining@uvic.ca. The no show fee will be waived in this instance. Please continue to visit UVic's COVID-19 website for up-to-date health and safety guidance. If sick, trainees are encouraged stay home and follow the public health guidelines.
