The Centre for Global Studies is pleased to offer associate fellowship opportunities from qualified researchers, professionals, and community members interested in our dynamic group of interdisciplinary scholars.

Purpose: The purpose of the associate fellowship is to create linkages with the broader scholarly community through mentorship opportunities, creating intellectual interdisciplinary capacity with the centre fellows/projects as well as community linkages in the area of global studies.

Topics: The CFGS promotes critical citizenship in a complex and rapidly changing global environment including the advancement and understanding of major global issues by civil society, the private sector, governments, and international institutions. Scholars and professionals are invited to apply who are engaged in similar topics of a global dimension. These topics may included, but are not limited to: global governance, international environmental challenges, ecological and social justice issues, and culture and identity. Applications from all disciplinary backgrounds are welcome.

Value: The Associate Program aims to be mutually beneficial to both the CFGS and the Associate. Associates are an important part of the CFGS intellectual community through enhanced opportunities for research networking, mentorship, and exchange. Through participation in the Centre's wide range of scholarly and social activities, Associate Fellows will help shape the development of the CFGS community. In addition, Associate Fellows will have access to the University of Victoria library, CFGS boardroom (C179), stationary, scanner, and photocopier. Please note that this is a **non-stipendiary** appointment with no cash value.

Eligibility: The fellowships are open to Canadian and international scholars; emeritus scholars; new scholars; scholars on sabbatical leave from their regular academic appointments; career professionals; and community leaders. Consideration will also be given to professionals in NGOs and other related fields. The CFGS recognizes there are many ways of knowing and encourage leaders with a variety of backgrounds.

- give at least one public seminar or lecture on the theme of their research
- acknowledge the CFGS in all publications arising from the fellowship and notify the Centre of any such presentations, books, or articles for inclusion in our database.

(approx. 100 words).

a concise summary of the projects and current work directed to an
interdisciplinary review committee (approx. 500 words).

a brief description of how your research speaks to or fits within the field of
Global Studies (approx. 250 words).

a brief description of how this interdisciplinary community will benefit
from your research, background, and/or professional experience and how
you hope to benefit from this community (approx. 100 words).

the names and full addresses of two (2) referees including institutional
affiliation & relationship to applicant.

The centre may also choose to solicit the opinions of other referees.

an up-to-date curriculum vitae

an up-to-date bio (150-300 words)
