A CFYS survey of UVic graduate students

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UVic has a strong commitment to community engagement. What does this mean for research? Currently, many research method courses do not include how to collaborate with community partners on project design, data collection, analysis or knowledge mobilization.



Of the 257 UVic students surveyed, 90% (229) were interested in learning CER.



Only 10% were not interested.



72% (182) reported not receiving any CER instruction.

Those students receiving CER instruction at UVic found the top three places for training were:




