

# Reports for 2022 UVRA AGM

## Benefits

### Health and Travel Insurance

Johnson has announced some minor alterations to the UVRA - Johnson Extended health and Prestige Travel plans, to take effect on September 1st, 2022. Two of the more important ones are: the addition of a 93-day option for out-of-province travel (with appropriate premium increase); trip cancellation will include having to cancel because of a positive COVID-19 test. Others are on the website.
