VICTORIA'S STORY HISTORIC TOUR

Enjoy a leisurely 90-minute walk through the heart of Victoria's historic Old Town with father-and-son team, John and Chris Adams. This is a special tour for UVic Retirees and their guests. It will start at the Visitor Centre (812 Wharf Street, at the corner of Government Street) and will explore nearby places of significance in the history of Victoria and British Columbia.
