

## **DEAN'S LIST**

The Dean's list recognizes undergraduate students' outstanding academic achievement in Science. The list is based on the grade point average (GPA) of all eligible students in each of three categories (see below for categories and eligibility criteria). In each category, students who rank in the top 10% based on GPA will be named to the Dean's list.

## **Eligibility**

To be eligible for the Dean's list, an undergraduate student must normally be a full-time student registered in a minimum of 12 academic units of study, of which 10.5 units are graded using the standard nine point scale, in two academic terms in the 12 month period (May to April) immediately preceding the adjudication of the recognition.

## **Categories**

- First Year Dean's List: recognizes outstanding academic achievement of first-year students. Includes the top 10% students based on the GPA during the period of eligibility as defined above. Students can only make this Dean's list once.
- In-Program Dean's list: recognizes outstanding academic achievement for students who are beyond first year but have not applied for graduation. Includes the top 10% students based on the GPA during the period of eligibility as defined above. Students may make this Dean's list more than once.
- Graduates Dean's List: recognizes outstanding academic achievement of students that have completed their program requirements and applied for graduation. Includes the top 10% students based on the graduating GPA.

Assessment for the Dean's List is done automatically once per year at the end of the spring term after all grades have been reported and processed.
