## 2024-25 School of Earth and Ocean Sciences <a href="MSERC Undergraduate Student Research Awards">MSERC Undergraduate Student Research Awards</a> (USRAs)

These awards provide financial support while you undertake a 16-week research project with a faculty member in SEOS. They are intended to nurture your interest and develop your potential for a research career in the natural sciences and to encourage you to undertake graduate studies.

Value: \$6000 plus a minimum 25% research top-up (\$1500)

Duration: 16 weeks starting May 1, 2024 or September 1, 2024 or January 1, 2025

## **Eligibility:**

- 1. Be a Canadian citizen or permanent resident of Canada.
- 2. Be registered at the time you apply in a bachelor's degree program at an eligible university; if you are studying toward a second bachelor's degree, you may still apply.
- 3. Completed all the course requirements of at least the first year of university study (or two academic terms) of your bachelor's degree by the time you hold the award.
- 4. Have been registered in at least one of the two terms immediately before holding the award (full or part-time).
- 5. NOT have started a program of graduate studies in the natural sciences or engineering.
- 6. USRAs may be held during co-op placements.
- You may hold only <u>ONE USRA</u> per fiscal year (April 1 to March 31) to a maximum of 3 NSERC awards throughout your university career.
- There is no longer a requirement that students applying for USRAs be enrolled full-time in their program to be eligible to apply.

## **Application Process/Procedures:**

- 1. Review potential **2024-25 SEOS Projects** (faculty proposals).
- 2. Contact faculty members whose research interests you to discuss their project and your suitability. You may approach faculty who have not posted specific projects.
- 3. There may be specific USRA funding for students of Indigenous ancestry. If you choose to do so, please self-identify on the SEOS cover sheet if this applies to you.
- 4. Submit the SEOS <u>application</u> that includes the application cover sheet, your CV, and a letter detailing your research interests and suitability for one or more SEOS projects.
- 5. Top students and alternates will be nominated by the SEOS UG Awards Committee. *Student nominees must then find a faculty supervisor by Friday, February 26<sup>th</sup>. Receipt of the USRA is contingent on a suitable match being found.* Faculty will also be notified and given access to nominee's applications.
