



LE,NOŃET Undergraduate Bursary Application



LE,NOŃET Bursaries are intended to supplement existing financial resources for Indigenous (First Nations Status/non-Status, Inuit and Métis) students currently enrolled in full-time undergraduate studies during the summer semester (May - August) at the University of Victoria.

Bursary Terms

Bursaries will be awarded to Indigenous undergraduate students with a demonstrated financial need, up to a maximum of \$3,000 annually (September – August).

Students may submit an application in both the fall and summer term and will be assessed based on their financial need and academic status at the time of application.

Due to limited funding, not all eligible applicants will receive financial support or the maximum funding allocation.

Eligibility

Applicants:

- Must be of Indigenous ancestry
- Must be an undergraduate student registered in a minimum of 4.5 units in each term for which they have applied for the bursary. Students registered with the Centre for Accessible Learning (CAL) are eligible for bursary assistance if registered in at least 3.0 units in each term of study
- Must be in good academic standing, with a GPA of 2.0 or higher
- Must be a Canadian citizen, permanent resident or a member of a First Nations band within Canada
- Students who have already received the maximum amount of \$3,000 for this program year will not be considered

Check-list

To be processed, the application must include:

- A letter of introduction (75-150 words) outlining Indigenous ancestry
- A completed, signed and dated application form
- A completed budget form

Application deadline is Friday, May 17, 2024 at 4:00pm

Late or incomplete applications will not be accepted.
