¹ CSC 105 in intended primarily for students in Economics or the School of Business. For Honours, we recommend CSC 110 or 111.

² To satisfy UVic's Academic Writing Requirement, complete one of ATWP 135 (formerly ENGL 135), ENGL 146, ENGL 147 or another approved course.

³ The Mathematics requirement can also be satisfied by the completion of MATH 100 or 109, 101, 200 and 211 or 110 (6.0 units in total). Mathematics requirements should normally be completed by the end of Year 2.

⁴ A course in statistics or quantitative methods will not count toward this requirement.

⁵ ECON 350 is required for ECON 400. SOSC 300 can be substituted for 1.5 units.

⁶ ECON 225 should normally be completed by the end of Year 2 and is a pre-or co-requisite for many 300-level courses and all 400 level courses.

⁷ Transfer students are encouraged to enrol in ECON 313 as soon as possible.

⁸ Students in the BA program require permission from the department to register in ECON 400 (and 401). (It is recommended ECON 400 be taken in the fall term in Year 4 with ECON 499). ECON 351 is required for ECON 401.
