Nomination Form

The nomination form along with the biographical sketch and statement of candidacy are not valid unless they are received in at <u>usec@uvic.ca</u> not later than **4:30pm on Tuesday, September 24, 2024.**

Eligibility

Persons eligible to stand for election, to make nominations and to vote shall be continuing sessional instructors. A continuing sessional is a person classified in university records as having continuing sessional status.

Withdrawal

Withdrawal by a person duly nominated as a candidate for election shall be made in writing to the University Secretary (see <u>Rules to Govern Elections to the Board of Governors and the Senate, section 8.1</u>).

Term of Office

The term of office for this position on Senate will begin as soon as practical and will end on June 30, 2026.
