Biography

Cole is a UVic B.A. (Hons.) graduate (2021) and current Doctoral Clinical Neuropsychology student in the Department of Psychology. A passionate researcher, his previous research examined concussion among elite athletes through patient-centered approaches. Broadly, his more recent research aims to better the lives of people struggling with brain injury, mental health, and addiction-related disorders. At the departmental level, Cole has held research and teaching positions and serves on several committees, including the Equity, Diversity, and Inclusion (EDI) Committee, where he advocates for students and promotes EDI through programs and events. Elected last year for a one-year term (2022-2023), Cole is a dedicated Student Senator. He serves on multiple Senate committees, representing the interests of students and steering change such as new degree programs, changes to existing programs, and the creation of a new Faculty of Health at UVic. Professionally, Cole has worked for non-profits in the fields of social services and healthcare.
