Adam was born and raised on the traditional lands of the  $x^w m \ni \theta k^w \ni \dot{\gamma} \ni m$  (Musqueam), Skwxwú7mesh (Squamish), and səlilwətał (Tsleil-Waututh) Nations, in the city of Vancouver, British Columbia. As a 4th generation descendent of the Chinese Diaspora in Canada, he is grateful to be able to embrace his rich cultural and spiritual lineage while living and working as a guest on the beautiful traditional lands of the ləkwəŋən peoples in Victoria, British Columbia.

Dr. Con is Professor of Music in Music Education and Choral conducting. He has conducted the UVic Chorus (est. 1969) since 2014 and currently conducts the Chamber Singers, the singing ambassadors of UVIC. In addition to music education methods courses, he coordinates Graduate Choral Conducting, and serves as graduate and undergraduate faculty supervisor for the accordion applied area. In Victoria, Adam is Artistic Director of the Capriccio Vocal Ensemble.

Dr. Con served three years as Acting Associate Dean for the Faculty of Fine Arts, three years as Chair of the Senate Committee on Curriculum and 5 years on the Senate Committee on Planning. For the past 10 years, he has coordinated the music for UVIC convocation ceremonies. He has served on the President's advisory committee and is now Vice-President of the Faculty Association.
