Nomination papers must be received by the Office of the University Secretary, Michael Williams Building, Room A138 or via email to usec@uvic.ca not later than 4:30 p.m. on Tuesday, July 23, 2024. If there is more than one nominee from each school, an online election will be conducted from 9:00am on Wednesday, July 24, 2024 until 4:00pm on Tuesday, July 30, 2024.

When nominating members to the Committee, constituencies should encourage diverse representatives from their membership to stand for election, including but not limited to: First Nations, Métis and Inuit peoples, and all other Indigenous peoples; members of groups that commonly experience discrimination due to race, ancestry, colour, religion and/or spiritual beliefs, or place of origin; persons with visible and/or invisible (physical and/or mental) disabilities; persons who identify as women; persons of marginalized sexual orientations, gender identities, and gender expressions; and others who may contribute to the diversification of the Committee.
